THEME

STRIVING FOR QUALITY

From Quality of Care to Quality of Life

Quality of care as a concept is becoming increasingly fluid and complex. Our record-breaking conference in Seville addressed multi-faceted aspects of quality: from personalisation of services, to service users' involvement and empowerment, to assessment and evaluation approaches, notwithstanding the role of technology in the organisation of services - including innovation and evidence-based frameworks.

But what does it mean for social services in practice? How do we advance care in the community across the life-cycle and progress towards person-led care? How do we move from talking about quality of care to caring about quality of life?

Bringing speakers and experts from across the globe, the 27th ESSC will discuss quality from a new viewpoint, while specifically addressing:

- How the latest innovations in social services planning, inspection, and assessment are improving quality of care?
- What are the latest trends and developments to improve the quality and impact of local social services and deliver whole-person care?
- How are professionals working with researchers, funders, and people using services to co-produce services that improve the quality of life?

YOUR CONTRIBUTION

- Evidence-based in-service evaluation and assessment; definition of measures and outcomes that matter to people
- Engaging and empowering people and communities in care development, implementation and evaluation
- Strategies to enhance the quality and impact of children's/disability/older people's services locally
- Quality frameworks in multi-agency work, integrated care and support for a variety of population groups
- New and promising local arrangements for safeguarding and promoting children's/disabled people's/older people's welfare
- New technology for social services planning, evaluation and assessment
- Cities' strategy for quality services

The European Social Services Conference (ESSC) is the annual flagship event of the European Social Network (ESN). Pioneering the value of knowledge exchange within the social services sector, next year's conference will look at quality person-led care as a way to improve services and transform people's lives.

WHY SUBMIT A PROPOSAL?

You will be able to:

INNOVATE – share new innovative ideas with international colleagues

INSPIRE – other European colleagues with you good practice, service models or projects

TRANSFER KNOWLEDGE – present best practice to your peers

GENERAL INFORMATION

Maximum 2 proposals per organisation only

Interactive Workshops

Mandatory: workshops must be interactive

(e.g. discussion groups for the audience, polls, question and answer elements)

Up to 28 workshops will be selected

Up to 7 workshops running parallel in 4 streams on 5 and 6 June

It is possible to have more than 2 presenters

30-80 delegates per workshop

Conference delegate workshop booking opens 21 February 2019

Presenters also need to book workshop sessions they are attending

(1 per stream = 4 in total)

Max. presentation 15 minutes

Total time: 1 hour

Thematic Panel Discussions

4 sessions running in parallel with 4 panellists per session on 7 June

1 presenter on stage per organisation

150-250 delegates per panel discussion

10-minute presentation with PowerPoint and moderated discussion

Opportunity to discuss a certain theme or topic with peers from across Europe

Project Forum

5-minute 'elevator pitch' style

2 sessions on 6 and 7 June

1 presenter on stage

All delegates are able to attend

5 projects per session

5 slides in 5 minutes max.

Different to longer presentations, this involves outlining the main points of your project in 5 slide max.
